The Commonwealth Government determines both the basic daily fee and the means-tested care fee. The basic daily fee is set at 85% of the full single aged pension. The Home sets the price of the room based on the size, style and amenities provided.

1. The basic daily care fee.

The basic daily fee is \$63.57 per day and is paid by every resident. It is an amount that everyone pays for the day-to-day services they will receive at the aged care Home. These can include meals, cleaning, laundry, heating and cooling and some group activities. The fee is set by the Commonwealth Government at 85% of the full single aged pension. It is adjusted twice a year in line with the Government's pension review.

2. The means tested care fee.

The means-tested care fee is additional to the basic daily fee. A contribution that some people pay towards the cost of their care. To find out more about these fees and charges you will need to complete a request for "Income and Assets" test; visit <u>Services Australia</u> or call 1800 227 475.

3. The accommodation payment.

The accommodation payment includes the cost of your room, bathroom facilities, communal areas and where available private air conditioning. Accommodation payments can be a Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD) or a Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP) or a combination of both a RAD and DAP. You may be eligible to receive financial support in full or in part from the Government. This is determined when you complete an income and assets assessment application.

4. Additional services charges.

These charges will vary depending on additional services requested by you and provided by Doutta Galla Aged Services.
